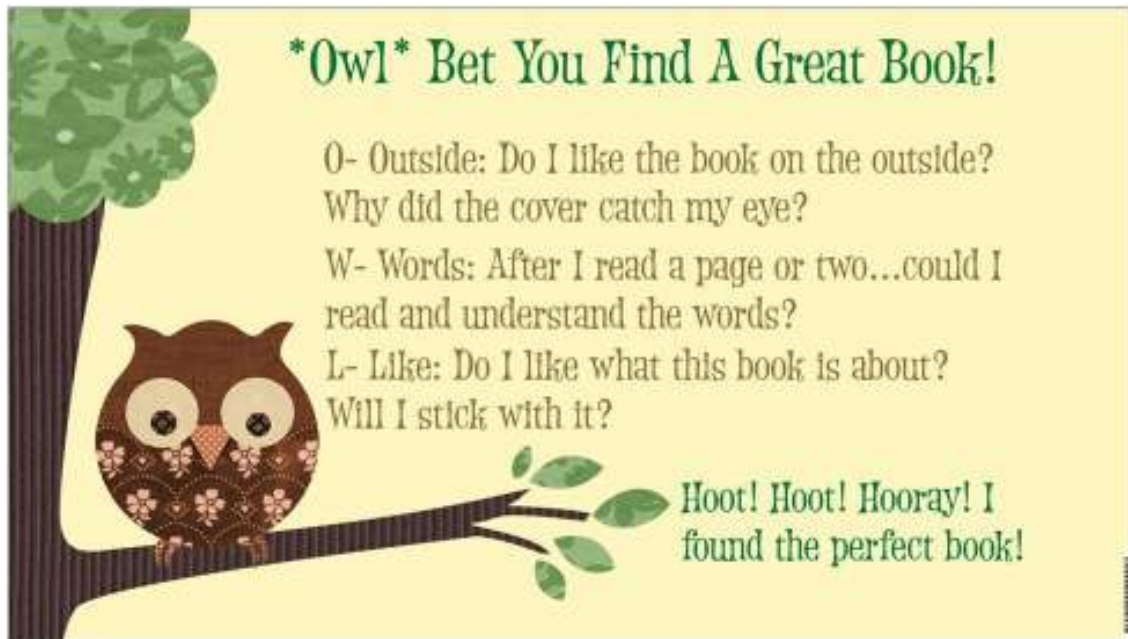

HOMework

I'm very excited about the homework folders that I have created for students this year. They have a pocket for each subject. Folders should go home each night and come back each day. Students will usually have the following assignments each night: Math (workbook page or worksheet on the topic covered in class that day), Spelling, Vocabulary, Reading (a book of their choosing, 15-30 minutes), Get Reading Log signed and complete the response section, and Get Planner signed.

Students will receive a calendar at the beginning of each month for spelling and vocabulary. This calendar should stay in the homework folder for reference. Assignments are completed in the appropriate notebook.

If you could, please send in \$1 to cover my costs of the folders that I purchased.

Please notify me at least 24 hours in advance if you'd like to bring in a treat for your child's birthday. Due to our busy schedule, it is very important that we set up a time for birthday celebrations that will work for our class.

School hours this year are 8:00 - 3:00. If you need after-school care, please contact the office for more information.

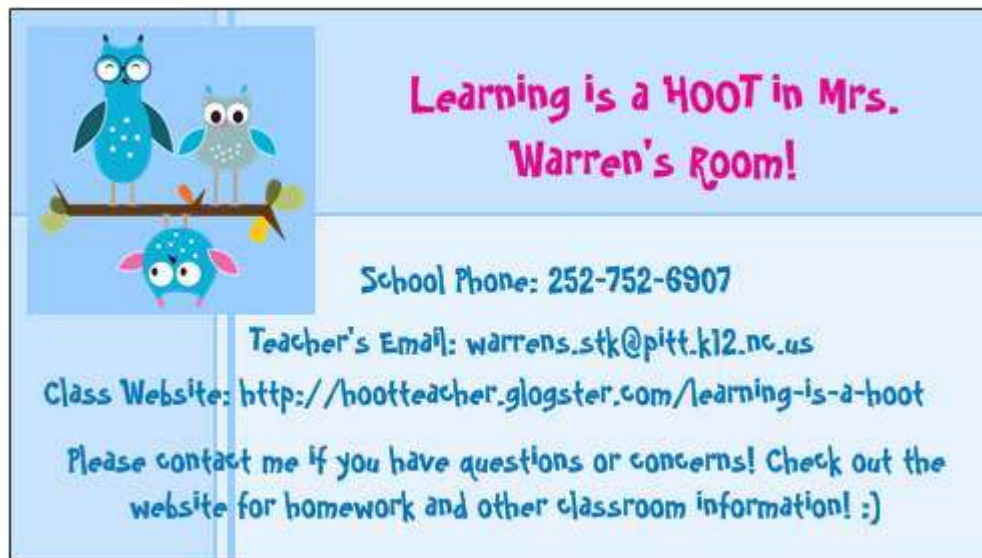

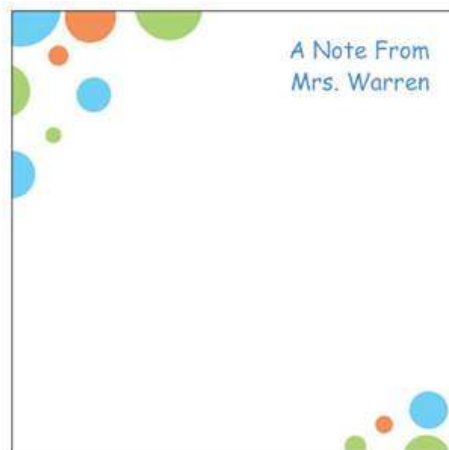

What Good Readers Do...

Before you read...

- Think about why you're reading. Reading for enjoyment is different than reading to locate facts.
- Preview the text by looking at the title, pictures, or headings so you can think about what you already know.
- Make predictions. What do you think the book will be about?

While you read...

- Listen to yourself read in your mind. If a word doesn't sound right, reread that sentence again. What word would fit in the sentence? Can you find little words within the bigger word?
- Think about what you are reading. Connect your background knowledge and make connections.
- Stop and review if you are reading something and you don't understand. Longer texts are sometimes hard to get through. Chunk them into smaller parts.

After you read...

- Summarize what you read. Think about the characters, the problem, the solution.
- If you are reading non-fiction, go back and read any sub-headings and try to remember the facts.
- Discuss what you read with someone.
- Encourage others to read what you have just finished. Tell them why it's a good read!



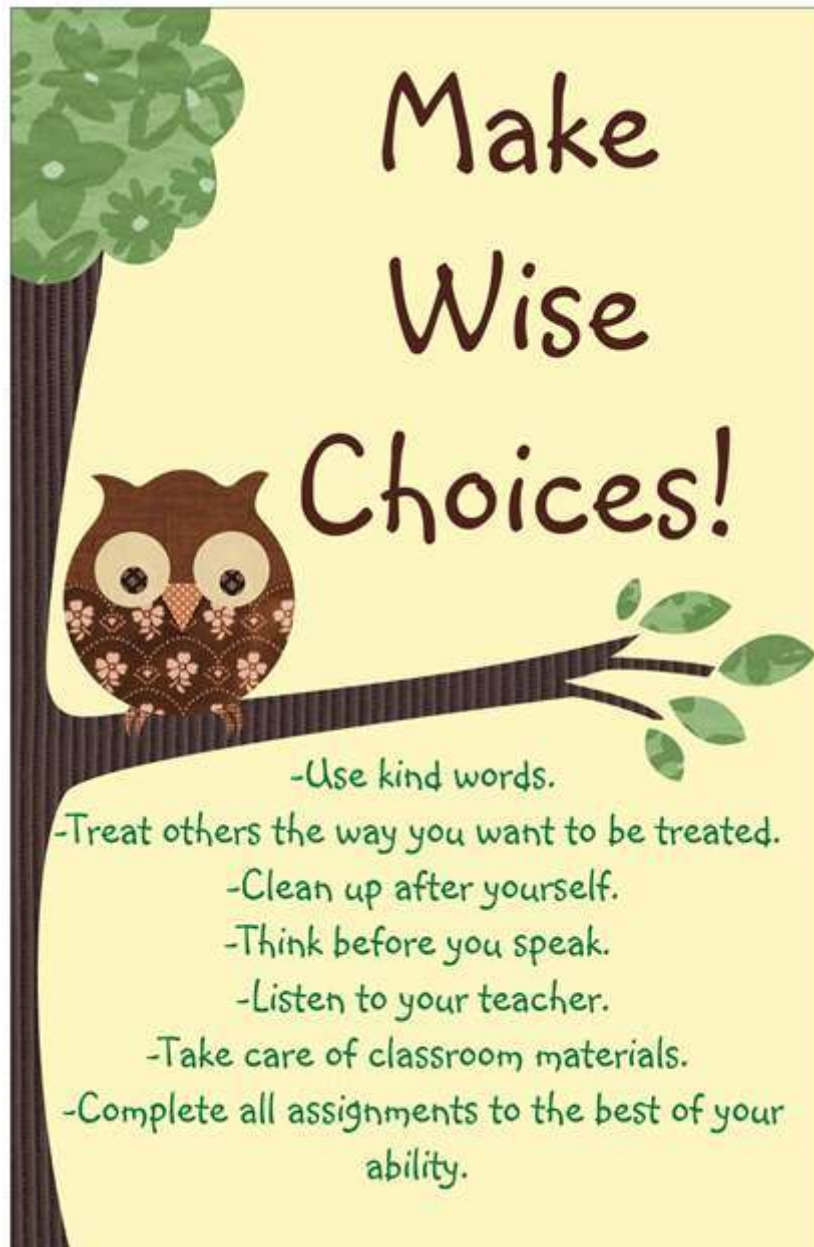
